Motor Behavior Sep 30 2019 In recent years there has been steadily increasing interest in motor behavior and a growing awareness that a person not only has to know what to do in a particular situation, but also how to do it. The question of how actions are performed is of central concern in the area of motor control. This volume provides an advanced-level treatment of some of the main issues. Experiments concerned with basic processes of motor control typically examine very simple movements. At first glance these tasks appear to be far removed from real-world tasks, but it should be kept in mind that they are not studied for their own sake. One of the main reasons for using them is the well-recognized, but sometimes questioned, scientific principle that basic laws may be discovered more easily in simple situations than in complex situations. Another reason is that the simple tasks studied constitute building blocks of more complex tasks. The first two chapters of the present volume focus on behavioral and physiological studies of programming and preparation of movements. In the first chapter D.
